Reviewed the action items from last (January 10, 2006) meeting:

--- Letters of intent from cooperating municipalities and MS4s (a commitment letter on letterhead from T and V of Victor, T of Farmington, T and V of Macedon, T of Walworth, T of Ontario and the Ontario and Wayne County Highway Departments)

- Still need to contact T of Walworth

**WQIP Proposal Outline – (attached).** David Zorn went through the outline, suggested that Minimum Measures 3, 4, and 5 are the most important. **Asked for comments or revisions to the outline by the end of February**

**The following items are needed by the end of February in order to write WQIP proposal** (from the Description and Funding sections of the attachment):

- **List of what work**, if any, has been done under this program
- **List of any funding sources** that have been used or applied for to implement the Stormwater Phase II MS4 program
- **Letters of intent** from cooperating municipalities and MS4s (a commitment letter on letterhead from T and V of Victor, T of Farmington, T and V of Macedon, T of Walworth, T of Ontario and the Ontario and Wayne County Highway Departments) indicating the commitment to work together on implementing the program (6 MM) and providing the match. **Template is attached.**
- **Documentation of WQ Impairment** - County Health violations, Report or study indicating a violation of water quality standards, Assessment of wildlife management plans, wildlife and/or habitat restoration plans
- Is this **part of priority in a funding source**, management plan or program
- **Does this program contribute** to a comprehensive and coordinated approach to solving water quality impairments and/or restoring aquatic habitat. Consistent with existing:
  - County WQ Strategy
  - Approved watershed management plan
  - Local Waterfront Revitalization Program
  - NYS Coastal Nonpoint Pollution Control Program
  - DEC approved species or habitat management plan or project
  - NYS Open Space Conservation Plan
- **Enforcement Status** – is the Municipality under enforcement
- **Funding** – this is a 50/50 match grant. It appears that if all 9 entities were included in proposal the grant amount would be approximately \$165,000-\$200,000. That would require approximately \$50,000 in cash match from the nine entities and the remainder in in-kind match.
